

**The Aztec Stadium**



The Aztec Stadium or "The Colossus of Saint Ursula" is the third largest stadium in the world, after the Rūngnado May First Stadium in Pyongyang, North Korea and the Salt Lake Stadium in Kolkata, India. It was named "Azteca" through a contest, in which all fans throughout the country were invited to propose a name.

The full construction took nearly four years to complete. Ten architects, thirty-four engineers, fifteen technicians, and eight hundred workmen were employed during the construction. Architects and engineers responsible for the work chose the rocky area that the eruption of the Xitle volcano left to reach a firm surface on which to build.

The Aztec Stadium was inaugurated on May 29, 1966 by the President of Mexico, Gustavo Díaz Ordaz and the President of FIFA, Sir Stanley Rous. 120,000 spectators gathered to see a match between the Mexican America Club and the Italian Club Torino, which ended with a 2-2 draw and whose inaugural goal, within 10 minutes of the game, was scored by the Brazilian Arlindo Dos Santos Cruz from the America Club.

From that moment, the Aztec Stadium turned into the "Mexican soccer cathedral" and became a great stage for major sporting events like the World Cups of 1970 and 1986; musical concerts by U2, Michael Jackson and Elton John among others; and religious events such as Pope John Paul II's visit in 1999. Converted into a synonym of popularity for anyone who could fill it, the Azteca recorded an impressive presence of 132,274 fans in the fight between the boxers Julio César Chávez and Greg Haugen, carried out in 1993. A year after, the Cowboys and the Oilers played the American Bowl, with record attendance.

In its 47 years of existence, this historic stadium has lived an endless number of unforgettable historic moments. The 1970 World Cup showcased the talents of what was arguably the greatest team of all time; Pele, Carlos Alberto, Rivelino and Jairzinho. During the 1986 quarter final between England and Argentina, Diego Maradona scored his legendary 'Hand of God goal' and 'Goal of the Century', according to FIFA voters. The Azteca's history is so inextricably linked with some of greatest moments, as a result, will always be one the world's most famous sporting venues.

**Chiles en Nogada** is a traditional dish from Mexican cuisine. It consists of "*chiles poblanos*" stuffed with a mixture of meat, dried fruits and spices covered in walnut sauce, and garnished with pomegranate seeds. It is said that this dish was invented by nuns in the town of **Puebla** to celebrate the country's independence granted in **1821**, and to entertain the emperor **Augustin de Iturbide** on his birthday. Since this dish contains ingredients that are the colors of Mexico's flag it is considered a very patriotic and festive dish. September is definitely the best month to enjoy this delicious and patriotic dish.

## Driving in Mexico City

It is strongly recommended to first get an introduction to driving rules in Mexico City. Here you can find some basic driving lessons:

- The use of the **honk** is very common. It is usually used to alert others when passing an intersection without stopping, frustration and encourage others to move faster.
- Since the city is huge a **GPS navigation system** is a good investment. A navigation App, such as **WAZE** is very good to avoid traffic jams.
- If you get lost you can ask people with great knowledge in the city like **taxi drivers**.
- Never leave your car unattended in the street; preferably leave it with **valet parking** when visiting a restaurant or bar, and make sure not to leave valuable belongings in it.
- If a valet parking is not available, use a parking lot or **parking garage** – they have reasonable rates of \$10-20 pesos per hour and guarantee security.
- Otherwise, use the **parking meters** which have been installed in streets like Polanco, Condesa, and Roma Norte; make sure to pay the fee to avoid any fine.
- In Mexico it is very common to find a guy who offers help to watch over your car, they are call “**viene-viene**” because that’s what they repeat to help you parking, When they stop saying those words or hit the rooftop hard, make sure to break before hitting the other car. Make sure to **tip** them when you leave.
- Mexico City is very likely to **floods** and **traffic jams** so try to keep calm and take your preventions while driving during a storm.
