**Mexico City** is a festive shopping destination where you will find a wide array of colorful outdoor street markets. Depending on what catches your eye, there is a great diversity of products bartered, traded and sold. These places have everything imaginable, from antiques, furniture and household goods to food and clothing.

Traditional markets link the present with the past. They are a good place to meet the locals and for locals to meet visitors. There is constant movement of people, with many shouting out to potential customers. There are a number of fantastic markets in Mexico City, here are some of the most famous: **Bazar de Sabado** in San Angel, where artists offer their paintings / **Mercado de Artesanias** in Coyoacan, featuring handicrafts from all over the country / **Sonora Market**, famous for its ceramics and herbs. **Ciudadela** with more than 200 stalls / **La Lagunilla** with some of the best antiques / **La Merced**, the largest retail market of Mexico City / **Mercado de Alvaro Obregon** and **Mercado de Medellin** in Colonia Roma / **Sunday Art Market** in Sullivan.

Recommendations, bring small bills, exact change is always appreciated. Bargain with a light touch often gets the best results. Many vendors will give bigger discounts if you're buying several items at once. **Enjoy your visit!**

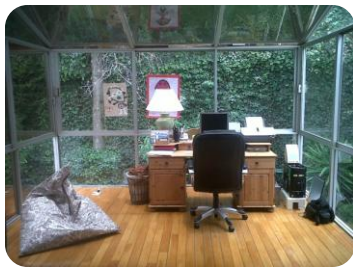
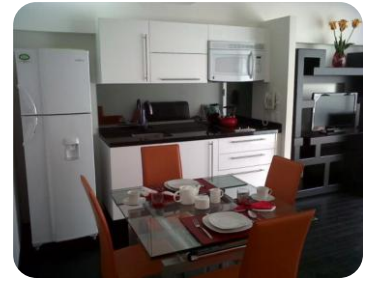
